

On Tuesday, April 27, we moved the KC1DLN repeater to the top of Peaked Mountain in Dixmont. Testing has been going on all week and is showing great coverage! The frequency is 147.015 DCS 432, this is a Yaesu System Fusion machine that is linked to the N1UB repeater in Sidney, 146.625 Tsql 114.8 . The repeaters are connected to wires-x room 62148 UFB New England and FCS reflector 00339. The repeaters will also operate in FM analog mode, but are not linked in FM.






