This event promises to be more than just a gathering; it's an excellent opportunity for both seasoned POTA veterans to explore new parks, as well as for newcomers to experience the thrill of Parks On The Air firsthand. If you're curious about this wonderful hobby, we encourage you to join us, ask questions, get on the air, and even earn a unique POTA award!

The official POTA event will be taking place from October 18-19 UTC. We'll be meeting on Saturday, October 18th, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM EDT, but feel free to arrive early or linger longer to soak in the camaraderie.

Since Clough State Park has a bit more space than our previous venues, we'll be using simplex communications on 446.100 MHz to keep everyone connected.
